## Love at the heart of the Fregoli project

Fregoli Theatre Company have a very close association with Roscommon. Although Galway-based, their artistic director Maria Tivnan, and one of the company members, her cousin Jarleth Tivnan, hail from Boyle.

The company enjoyed a short residency at the arts centre this summer, when they began work on *I Salute Magpies*. Now, Fregoli embark on their first main stage performance at Roscommon Arts Centre this Friday evening with a gorgeous show about love in all its forms.

Entitled *The Fregoli Heart Project*, this is a play created from stories submitted by the public about love. Last October,

Fregoli Theatre Company put out an open call to the public to send them their stories of love. The public duly responded not only with their stories but with their pictures and voice recordings, and with contributions from children as young as six years right up to people in their 80s, there was more than enough material for the project.

The stories expressed love for family, friends, humanity, nature, occupation, and of course romance and what Fregoli will present on stage this weekend is the story of these stories.

Maria says: "Making this play involved a large creative team: a visual artist who ignites the

piece with colour and imagination; a musician and composer whose original music brings a beautiful quality to the play; four core performers who bring most of the stories to life with skill, energy, and sincerity; the Bohermore Drama group who have created a lovely engaging piece about their pride in and love of their place and home, and the Real Action Dance group whose love of dance can only be expressed in the joy of high energy moves and rhythms."
